Staff Attorney Position Announcement

The Children's Law Center of Central North Carolina (CLC) is a nonprofit organization based in Winston-Salem providing children with quality legal advocacy focusing on domestic violence issues, high-conflict custody cases, and the rights of children in public education. CLC is searching for a Part-Time Staff Attorney who will successfully advocate for the otherwise voiceless children in our community. The Staff Attorney serves as Guardian ad Litem to children involved in Forsyth County Chapter 50B civil domestic violence cases and Chapter 50 high-conflict custody cases.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

Interviewing the parties, children and collateral witnesses;
Reviewing civil and criminal court records;
Preparing written reports for the court;
Managing individual caseload and attending court hearings;
Participating, as appropriate, on community collaboratives; and
Assisting in the supervision of volunteers and law students.

Qualifications:

Juris Doctorate from an accredited law school;
North Carolina law license, or willingness to become licensed in North Carolina
3-5 years of experience preferably in child advocacy or family law;
Strong written and oral communication skills;
Good time management and organizational skills; and
Ability to work independently and to accept supervision.

Part-Time Position. Three days per week. Salary is commensurate with experience; annual salary range is \$30,000- \$33,000. Benefits are not currently offered. Flexible work environment.

Position has potential to become full-time.
